Something bad seemed to happen to me on the 13th of every month and I avoided dating letters or writing cheques on the 13th or doing anything important on that date. On the 29th of December 2012, I had to be rushed to Monash Hospital with unforeseen cardiac, renal and other complications. My wife and I were apart when the New Year dawned for the first time in 56 uears. When she rang me at midnight and wished me in my hospital room, I could tell that she was as overcome with sadness as I was. I experienced severe discomfort as those wonderful and skilled doctors and surgeons worked hard in their various fields to discover what was causing my problems and to correct them. Whilst dialysing at regular intervals, I had to undergo ultrasound tests of the abdomen, a nuclear scan of the heart, then an invasive procedure to remove some rascally gall stones and, finally, a complete removal of the gall bladder. As if that was not enough, a very virulent bacteria was also running rampant inside me and cultures had to be grown to identify it and antibiotics prescribed and administered to destroy it. Needless to say, the only arm that could be used for all these blood letting and port insertions is now black and blue all over. Thankfully, there was no lasting damage to the heart So, here I am, back in the saddle and as weak as a pup. However, I must thank all my friends who rallied round June and gave her moral support. Also, thank you to them for their prayers and good wishes. My thanks also to the superb medical staff at Monash and Jessie MacPherson Hospitals for their dedication and care and to the nursing staff in those extablishments whose care and expertise are second to none! LASTLY, I THANK GOD FOR MY JUNE WHO CONTINUES TO NURSE AND PUT UP WITH MY GRUMPY WAYS!

Rs.2000 to Mrs Hilda Holmes. House was entirely flooded after heavy rains.

Thanks to the generosity of our members, the Committee has decided to increase the welfare benefit paid to all 210 beneficiaries from Rs.2500 to Rs.3000 a month. Thus, the quarterly amount paid to each will be Rs.9000 per quarter. This increase will be paid in April, when the second quarter payments will be made. ANOTHER EXAMPLE OF HOW YOUR MONEY IS SPENT

On the left is Mrs Yvonne Muller carrying her 15 year old grandson, Joshua. Since birth, Joshua has not been able to talk, walk or sit due to being born with Cerebral Palsy. He also gets epileptic seizures for which he takes four tablets a day which are bought from a chemist. He is cared for by his grandparents as his mother and father abandoned him when he was one year old. His grandmother has to carry him everywhere and, since he is also incontinent, she has to change his nappies, when necessary. The trio live in an old oven which was once part of a bakery but has now been converted into living quarters of a sort and pay a rent of Rs.4,500 a month.. One can only imagine how much it must cost to maintain such a handicapped child as he has to wear PAMPERS all the

time. Having considered the circumstances, this Club has added Joshua to its list of Welfare Beneficiaries with immediate effect.
