STATEMENT OF PURPOSE.

The Eighty Club Melbourne Incorporated is a non-political, non-sectarian, non-profit organization established solely for charitable community service purposes.

- **A.** It has, as its main objective, the relief of poverty in Australia and in the Burgher community in Sri Lanka who, by reason of youth, age, infirmity, disablement, poverty, homelessness, educational disadvantage, and/or social and economic circumstances have a need for assistance in every form, including monetary gifts or pensions, special purpose donations, educational and training supplements, food, clothing and other basic needs.
- **B.** With respect to relief of poverty in Australia, such relief shall include monetary gifts to charities approved by Federal or State Governments and their Instrumentalities.
- **C.** In support of the objectives, the Eighty Club will levy subscriptions on members, circulate newsletters to members about activities and achievements, organize fundraising events, raffles, special appeals, solicit donations for both specific and general purposes and perform all such matters that are incidental to and conducive to the maximization of its purpose and objectives.

Membership shall be limited to persons who have an interest in providing assistance to the needy members of the Burgher community in Sri Lanka.
